### OPTING-IN

Racecourses need to know which bookmakers will be in attendance 24 hours in advance of each race meeting.

Accordingly, bookmakers must opt-in by email to Tim Moore at AGT by midday two days beforehand i.e. for Wednesday 2 December by midday on Monday 30 November (but for this Wednesday only - by close of play on Monday 30 November). An opted-in list will be made available on the AGT 24hrs in advance of each raceday.

### OBTAINING ENTRY BADGES

Entry badges, DBB / staff entry ticket, must be obtained by online application – <https://jcartickets.thejockeyclub.co.uk/Online/default.asp>

Bookmakers should print their DBB & entrance ticket take to the racecourse to be shown upon request. The DBB will admit the bookmaker.

### RACEDAY

In accordance with government guidelines, bookmakers & staff from Tier 3 areas are permitted to travel to work in Tier 2 locations but must maintain Tier 3 protocols.

Upon arrival at the racecourse a member of staff will direct bookmakers to the parking area and entrance to the course.

Face coverings are a mandatory entry requirement and must be used at all times whilst on racecourse premises.

Betting positions will be determined in a Covid secure manner in order to maintain social distancing and bookmakers will be pitched in by the BRM.

An AGT Pitch Fee will be payable to the BRM on the day.

Totepool & in most cases betting shop/s will also be in operation.
